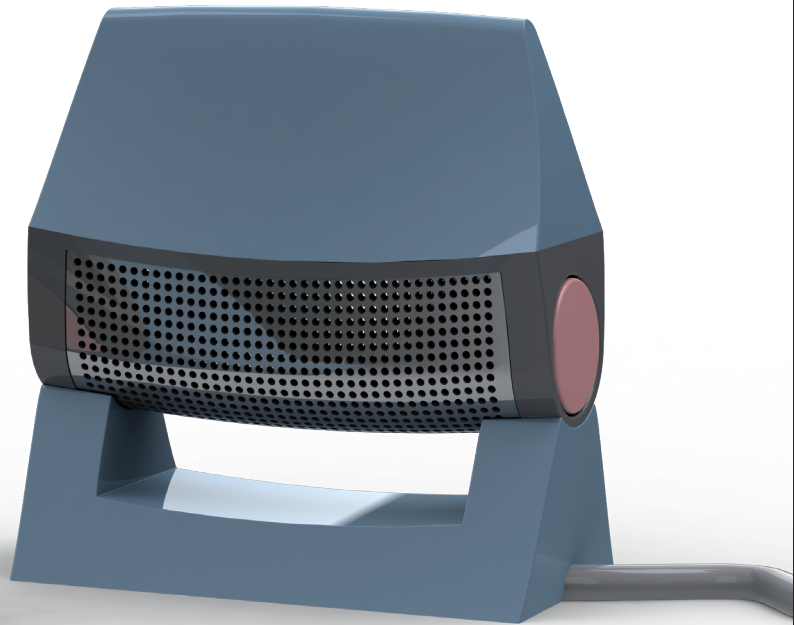
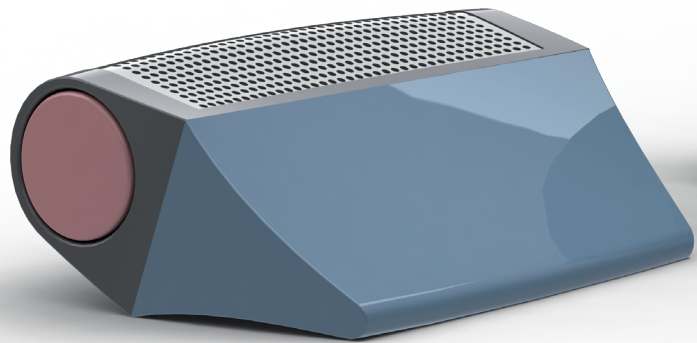




Inside - Outside

ZinZin

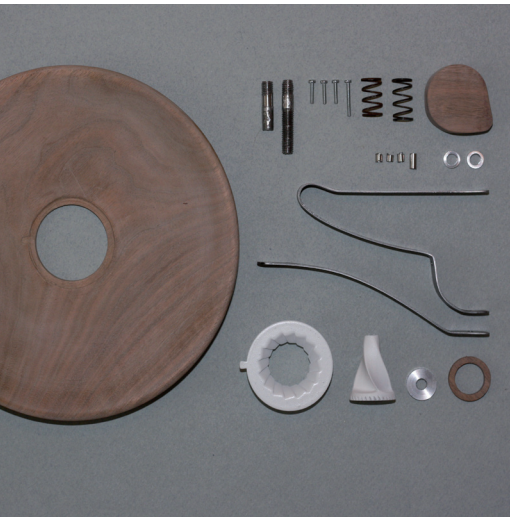

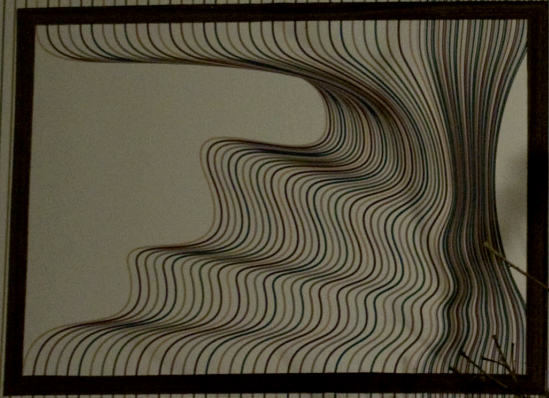
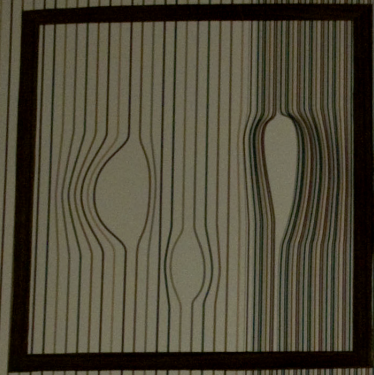




CoffeeGrinder

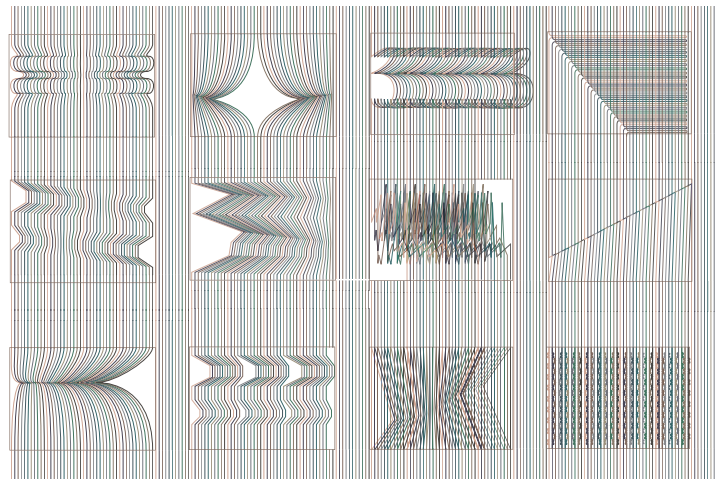
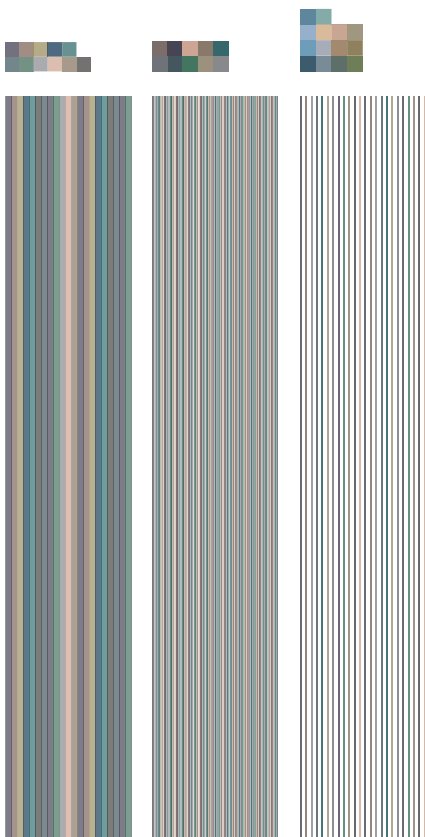
This coffee grinder was designed to support the emotional aspect of the coffee ritual in nowadays hectic daily routine. The user is supposed to pay attention to the amount of coffee he is consuming - and how. With the grinder, there is the chance to enjoy a cup of coffee consciously. The relationship between object and consumer is supported by the individual ways to use it. One can put it on top of a glass or between the legs and it is also possible to have different positions with the hand that holds the grinder. The number of parts was reduced to the essential. This minimalism guarantees a low material consumption. One can take the parts simply apart what is helpful to clean the machine to have no rests of coffee inside, what is important to have a pure aroma.

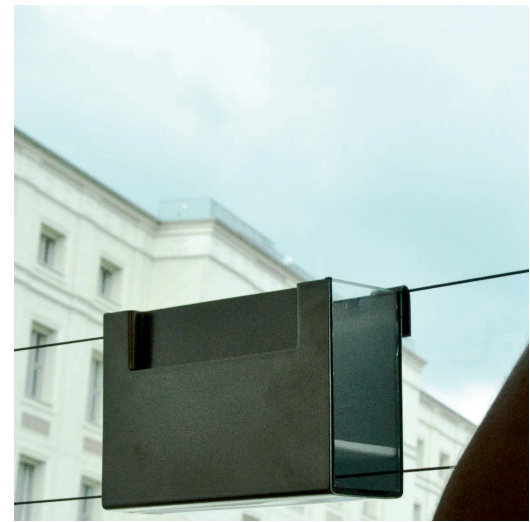
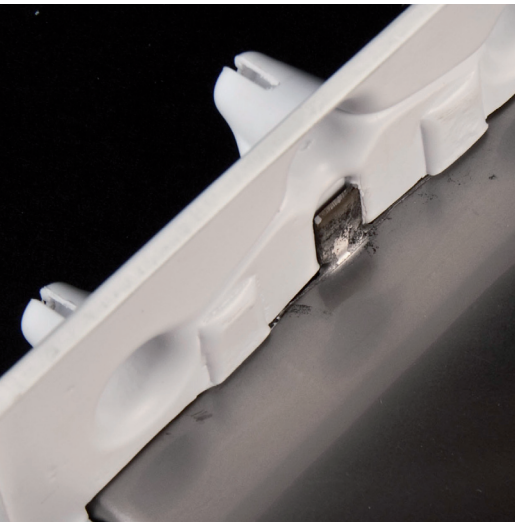
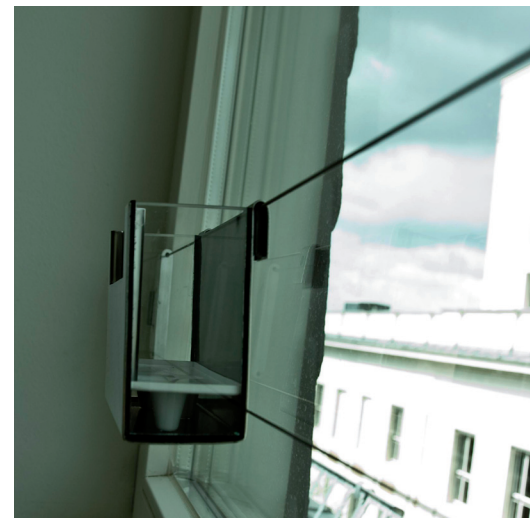


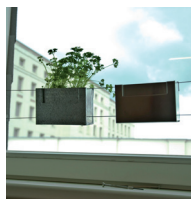
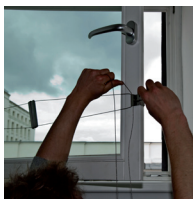
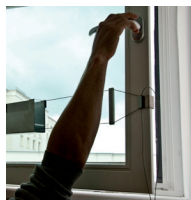
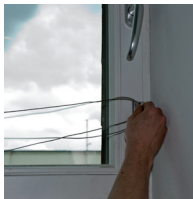


Herbie

This award-winning project was developed together with two other students, Michael Eberlein and Falk Neubert in cooperation with the company Rösle. It's design is made to fit the Rösle kitchen sytem perfectly.

It is a kitchen appliance that can be used to grow herbs by the window while enabling you to easily remove it from its growing spot in order to transport it to your cooking space. A special suspension fixes the box on the window, fitting every frame equally. Herbie is easy to install and remove without damaging your window in any way. After installing this flowerpot, you can open the window without moving your plants. Thanks to its efficiently crafted water tank and special granulate, you only need to water your herbs once a week.







Accessoire

This item is a modern version of the corset. There are three versions of this design, which form a series together. The design isn't merely to be seen as a kind of belt, but can also function on other levels as well, for example as a bracelet. The aim was to create a body-related shape that combines two saddle shaped forms.
